

UNIT 7: LIFE PLAN (FUTURE)

1. Will

We use "will" when:

- Making **predictions** (things we believe or guess about the future):
 - *It will rain tomorrow.*
 - *He will win the game.*
- Making **quick decisions** at the moment of speaking (no prior plan):
 - *I'm hungry! I'll order pizza.*
 - *The phone is ringing. I'll answer it.*
- Making **promises, offers, or threats**:
 - *I will help you with your homework.*
 - *I will never forget your kindness.*

2. Going to

We use "going to" when:

- Talking about **plans or intentions** (things you already decided to do):
 - *I'm going to visit my grandmother next week.*
 - *They're going to buy a new car soon.*
- Making predictions based on **present evidence** (you see or know something now):
 - *Look at those clouds. It's going to rain.*
 - *He's going to fall if he keeps climbing like that.*

Quick Comparison:

Situation	Example with "will"	Example with "going to"
A decision made now	<i>I'll call her right away.</i>	<i>(Not used)</i>
A planned action	<i>(Not natural)</i>	<i>I'm going to call her tomorrow.</i>
Prediction (based on evidence)	<i>(General guess) It will be sunny later.</i>	<i>Look! It's going to be sunny soon.</i>

1. **Prediction:** *I think he _____ (win) the race.*
 - Answer: *will win*

 - Answer: *are going to visit*
