

Present simple forms of 'to be' – am/is/are

Rewrite the sentences using the short forms of *be*.

EXAMPLE: They are good friends ⇒ They're good friends.

1 She is fantastic ⇒ She is fantastic.

2 We are in Spain ⇒ in Spain.

3 You are not my friend ⇒ You my friend.

4 Sheila is from Brighton. \Rightarrow Sheila is from Brighton.

5 The chairs are not expensive. \Rightarrow The chairs expensive.

6 I am not British ⇒ British.

7 Clara is a good student. ⇒ Clara is a good student.

8 You are great. ⇒ great.
