You may think that fashion designers spend a long time thinking of completely new styles and trends. <sup>0</sup> g The 'grunge' style of the 1990s has been very popular again for a few years. <sup>1</sup> \_\_\_\_ They sometimes don't even tie the laces of these.

And 1980s fashion was very similar to the 'punk' fashion of the 1970s – mixing formal clothes with casual ones. If this trend continues, we can imagine the trends in fashion 30 and 40 years from now.
