

How do Regular Verbs form the Past Simple? Regular verbs always end in **ED**
WRITE THE PAST FORMS. USE CAPITAL LETTERS ONLY

1 - Verbs that end in E just add D

Fake - faked

Like		Circle		Unite	
Love		Dance		Care

Arrive		Cure		Live	

2 – Verbs that end in Consonant + Y Drop the Y and add IED

Hurry - hurried

Try		Worry		Deny	
Cry		Satisfy		Apply	
Carry		Justify		Reply	
Marry		Supply		Empty	

3 – Verbs (of one syllable) that end in Consonant + vowel + consonant, double the consonant and add ED. Wrap - wrapped

Stop		Beg		Drag	
Drop		Trap		Knit	
Plan		Chop		Chat	
Skip		Crop		Spot	

4 – All the other verbs add ED

Mix - mixed

Start		Lock		Talk	
Work		Listen		Fix	
Laugh		Play		Finish
