


Yes, it is! No, it isn't!

Americans like to talk fast, so they make **contractions**.

Listen and repeat!



contract = make smaller

contraction = making 2 longer words into one short word

is + not = isn't

you + are = you're

To make the words short, we **remove** (take out) letters.

couldn't
could + not

you'll
you + will

This is an **apostrophe**. It shows **where** we removed letters.
