EXAMPLE OF DISCUSSION TEXT

TITLE	The Use of Social Media Among Teenagers
ISSUE	Does the use of social media have a positive or negative impact on teenagers?
ARGUMENT "FOR"	Social media can help teenagers enhance their social skills by connecting with peers, provides easy access to educational resources and information, and fosters creativity through platforms that allow self-expression and content creation.
ARGUMENT "AGAINST"	However, excessive use of social media can lead to addiction, reducing time spent on important activities like studying or socializing in person, while also exposing teenagers to inappropriate content, cyberbullying, and negative effects on mental health such as anxiety and low self-esteem.
RECOMMENDATION	Teenagers should be encouraged to use social media responsibly by setting time limits, being selective with the content they consume, and receiving guidance from parents and educators on how to manage its impact on their well-being.
