Visit Paris

Paris is the capital of France and it's a fascinating city. It's a great place for tourists because there are many interesting museums, parks and neighbourhoods to visit.

The Eiffel Tower is France's most well-known tower. It took two years to build and it was completed in 1889. The tower is 324 metres high. But you don't have to climb the 1,665 steps to the top floor – you can take a lift. The views from the top are incredible! Did you know that there is also a secret flat at the top of the tower that you can visit?

The Louvre is the largest museum in the world. There are more than 7,000 paintings in the Louvre, but the main attraction is the *Mona Lisa*, painted by Leonardo da Vinci. There are always crowds of people standing in front of it.

The River Seine is a very long river in France and part of it is in Paris. From the river, you can see many of Paris's beautiful buildings including the Louvre and the Eiffel Tower. Tourists often take cruise boats on the river or walk along it. There are even a couple of islands on the river. The famous Notre-Dame Cathedral is on one of the islands.

The Champs-Élysées is the most famous street in Paris. It is nearly two kilometres long and is visited by nearly 300,000 people every day. Sport events and parades take place on the street, but it's most famous for its many cafés and expensive shops.
