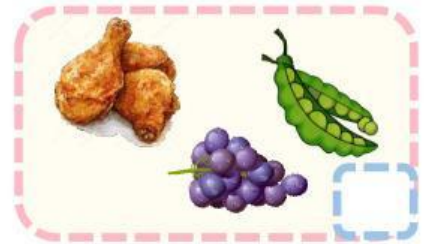

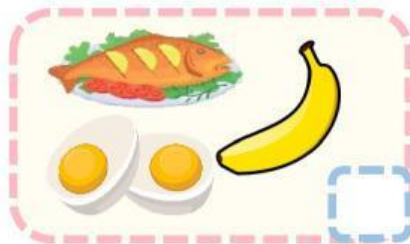
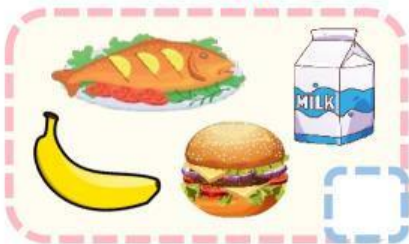
1. I **have got** grapes, limes and a drink.
