Direct: She said, "I am very tired."

- She said that she is very tired.
- She said that she was very tired.
- She said that she were very tired.

1. **Direct:** He said, "I love playing football."

- He said that he loves playing football.
- He said that he loved playing football.
- He said that he love playing football.

2. **Direct:** She said, "I can swim fast."

- She said that she can swim fast.
- She said that she could swim fast.
- She said that she may swim fast.

3. **Direct:** They said, "We are going to the park."

- They said that they were going to the park.
- They said that they are going to the park.
- They said that they was going to the park.

4. **Direct:** He said, "I will call you tomorrow."

- He said that he will call me tomorrow.
- He said that he would call me tomorrow.
- He said that he won't call me.

5. **Direct:** The teacher said, "You aren't allowed to eat."

- The teacher said that I wasn't allowed to eat.
- The teacher said that I weren't allowed to eat.
- The teacher said that I am not allowed to eat.

6. **Direct:** She said, "I don't like coffee."

- She said that she didn't like coffee.
- She said that she doesn't like coffee.
- She said that she don't like coffee.

7. **Direct:** He said, "I must finish my work."

- He said that he must finish his work.
- He said that he had to finish his work.
- He said that he have to finish his work.

8. **Direct:** The boy said, "I will go to the zoo."

- The boy said that he will go to the zoo
- The boy said that he would go to the zoo
- The boy said that he is going to the zoo.

9. **Direct:** She said, "I am reading a book."

- She said that she was reading a book.
- She said that she is reading a book.
- She said that she were reading a book.

10. **Direct:** They said, "We are travelling to Paris."

- They said that they are travelling Paris.
- They said that they would travelling to Paris.
- They said that they were travelling to Paris.
