## From Wild Hunters to Cozy Companions

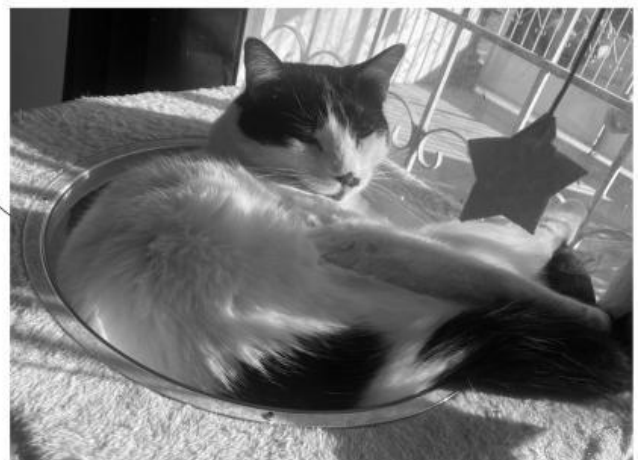
