

Lesson topic: Reading, listening, and writing activity

Lesson Aim:

- Grade 2 learners will practice listening, reading, speaking, and writing skills by listening to Good Friends story, answering question, and participating in discussion.
- Learners will practice word recognition, shared reading, and complete worksheets.

Grade level/Age: Grade 2(7 years)

Resources: Good Friends book, and audio recording of the texts

Introduction (5 minutes): Listening and speaking activities for the entire class

- Greeting the learners and engage them in singing a popular song if they know they happy they should clap their hands.
- Engage them in listening to the audio clip of the song and encourage them to sing along by stamping their feet or clapping their hands

Reading (10-15 minutes): Reading of the Good Friends book

- Ask the learners whether they recall the Good Friends story and allow them to retell it in sequence. Next, read the story together with children and have them respond to the questions:
 - ✓ What is the message of the story
 - ✓ What is the favorite part?
- After reading engage the entire class in discussion about their feeling in situation they do not someone/friend to play with. Have the learners share the feelings words.

State and write down feeling words/vocabulary: Friends, fun, happy, sad

Assessment (Listening, reading, and writing):

- Is the learner able to sing the song? Follow instruction, and participate in discussion

- Is the learner able to read the aloud with the teacher
- Is the student able to verbalize and write feeling words
