Column A: Glands	Column B: Functions
1. _____ Pituitary Gland	A. Secretes hormones that regulate other glands and body functions.
2. _____ Thyroid Gland	B. Produces insulin and glucagon to regulate blood sugar.
3. _____ Adrenal Glands	C. Secretes digestive enzymes into the small intestine.
4. _____ Pancreas (Endocrine)	D. Produces sweat to regulate body temperature.
5. _____ Pancreas (Exocrine)	E. Produces thyroxine, which controls metabolism.
6. _____ Sweat Glands	F. Releases adrenaline and cortisol to respond to stress.
7. _____ Salivary Glands	G. Produces saliva to aid digestion.
