A. GRAMMAR

❖ Connecting words (Từ nối)

- Từ nối trong tiếng Anh là những từ nằm trong câu được dùng để **nối 2 thành phần câu** với nhau (có thể là chủ thể, mệnh đề, nguyên nhân, etc.). Từ nối có thể dùng để **bổ nghĩa cho các tính chất** như nguyên nhân – kết quả, tương phản, nhấn mạnh, etc. của câu.

- Từ nối có thể đứng ở **đầu câu, ở giữa câu hoặc giữa hai dấu phẩy** tùy vào ngữ cảnh.

- Từ nối chỉ thời gian là những từ **bổ sung ý nghĩa** cho câu **về mặt thời gian**.

Ví dụ: I will call you **as soon as** I get to the office.

❖ Adjective + Preposition (Tính từ đi với giới từ)

- Chúng ta hay sử dụng **giới từ đi sau tính từ** để biểu hiện **cảm nhận, cảm xúc** của con người về các sự vật, sự kiện.

Ví dụ: We were **amazed by** what she told us.
