


Cells, tissues and organs:

Animals and plants are made of many cells. Different cells can take on different tasks. Each cell is specialised to carry out a particular function. Cells with different functions have different structures. The cell is adapted to carry out its function really well.

Some specialised animal cells:

Red blood cells:	These carry oxygen around the body.	
Nerve cells:	These transfer messages from one part of the body to another.
