


Panel Presentation

Part 1. Panel Structure

1. **Introduction.** Who introduces the discussion and who are the guests?

2. **First question.** What question does the host ask to open the conversation?

3. **Panelists' responses.** How do the panelists introduce themselves? What personal details do they provide about their study abroad experience?

4. **First impressions.** What did the panelists mention about the culture shock or first impressions when they arrived in the country they studied abroad?

5. **Concluding the panel.** How did the moderator end the panel?
