_____ **The Internet (1960s–1990s)** – Revolutionized communication, business, and access to information, shaping the modern world.

_____ **Personal Computers (1970s–1980s)** – Transformed work, education, and daily life by making computing power widely available.

_____ **Penicillin (1928)** – The first widely used antibiotic, saving millions of lives and leading to modern medicine.

_____ **The Transistor (1947)** – The foundation of all modern electronics, enabling the development of computers, radios, and smartphones.

_____ **Nuclear Power (1940s–1950s)** – Provided a powerful energy source and reshaped global politics with nuclear weapons.

_____ **The Airplane (1903)** – Revolutionized global travel, trade, and military strategy.

_____ **Television (1920s–1940s)** – Changed entertainment, news, and advertising, shaping mass culture.

_____ **The Automobile (Mass Production, 1908)** – Made personal transportation affordable and changed urban planning and industry.

_____ **The Mobile Phone (1973–1990s)** – Allowed instant communication, later evolving into smartphones that integrated multiple technologies.

_____ **The Birth Control Pill (1960)** – Gave women control over reproduction, significantly impacting society, economy, and gender roles.
