Naadam Festival, Mongolia

The Naadam Festival in Mongolia celebrates the traditional culture of the country. The festival is a holiday and people play traditional sports and games.

'Naadam' means 'festival of sports'. It's an old event – it started in **1921**. It lasts for **two** days and usually happens **around 11th July** every year. People wear traditional colourful clothes and often ride beautiful horses at the festival. All the towns in Mongolia celebrate the festival, but the biggest event is in the capital Ulaanbaatar.

People do three main sports at the festival: wrestling, archery and horse racing. Across the country, there are **about 22,400** wrestlers, 9,500 archers and **around 105,000** children who race horses at the festival. In wrestling, two men fight and try to push each other to the ground. Archery is done by both men and women. People can also watch shows in the evenings.

Every year, thousands of tourists visit Mongolia for the festival and try the traditional meals and drinks. They also buy souvenirs like traditional hats and clothes.
