The Great Wall of China

The Great Wall of China is one of the most famous structures in the world. It was built over 2,000 years ago to protect China from invaders. The wall is more than 21,000 kilometers long and stretches across mountains, rivers, and deserts. Many different dynasties helped build and repair the wall over hundreds of years.

The first emperor of China, Qin Shi Huang, started the major construction of the wall. Later, the Ming Dynasty made the wall stronger using bricks and stones. Soldiers and workers built watchtowers along the wall to look out for enemies.

Today, the Great Wall is a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Millions of tourists visit every year to walk on the wall and learn about its history. Some parts of the wall are well-preserved, but others have been damaged over time.


