Part 1: Greeting (5 marks)

Examiner asks the candidate these questions:

- Hello! / Hi! What's your name?
- How old are you?
- How are you today?

Part 2: Presentations (25 marks)

Set A: Look at the picture, talk about the pets you can see in the shop, then tell what pet you like most



Sample: They're fish. They're red and yellow. They're small. They're rabbits. They're white. They're cute. It's a dog. It's yellow. It's big. It's a turtle. It's green. It's small. It's a cat. It's white. It's cute. They're birds. They're yellow and green. They're cool!

Examiner gives some extra questions:

- How many (fish) are there?
- Are they (rabbits)? / Are they (big)?

Set B: Today you go to the zoo with your school. Let's talk about what animals you can see in the zoo, then tell what your favorite animal is.



Sample: In the zoo, I can see the elephants. They're big. They're grey. They're giraffes. They're yellow and tall. They're monkeys. They're brown and funny. They're tigers. They're black and yellow. They're cool. They're zebra. They're black and white. They're big. They're snakes. They're small. I like (elephants) but I don't like (snakes).

Examiner gives some extra questions:

- How many (giraffes) are there?
- Are they (tigers)? / Are they (in the tree)?
