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Causatives: Have / Get Something Done

Change these examples into the structure 'have + object + past participle' or 'get + object + past participle'. For example: I cleaned my kitchen (have) → I had my kitchen cleaned.

1. I / washed / my car. (have)

I had my car washed.

2. She /cut/ her hair. (get)

She got her hair cut.

3. They/ typed /the documents. (have)

They had the documents typed.

4. He /fixed/ my washing machine. (get)

He got my washing machine fixed.

5. Alice/ cut /her grass. (have)

Alice had her grass cut.

6. They painted my bedroom. (get)

They got my bedroom painted.

7. My uncle repaired my fridge. (have)

My uncle had my fridge repaired.

8. The cleaner tidied my garden. (get)

The cleaner got my garden tidied.

9. Tom edited her article. (have)

Tom had her article edited.

10. He cleaned their carpets. (get)

He got their carpets cleaned.

11. She printed my photos. (have)

She had my photos printed.

12. Mazi checked my teeth. (get)

Mazi got my teeth checked.

13. Bahadude cleaned his windows. (have)

Bahadude had his windows cleaned.

14. Mayte made her necklace. (get)

Mayte got her necklace made.

15. Gary delivered my furniture. (have)

Gary had my furniture delivered.

16. Mike repaired our roof. (get)

Mike got our roof repaired.

17. Afisi wrote their report. (have)

Afisi had their report written.

18. Sara dyed my hair. (get)

Sara got my hair dyed.

19. Erin sent her money. (have)

Erin had her money sent.



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
