<p><b>-Hablar de habilidades</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Cats <b>can't</b> read.</li><li>• She <b>can</b> dance.</li><li>• They <b>can't</b> swim.</li><li>• We <b>can</b> use a computer.</li><li>• Can you <b>read the text</b>?</li><li>• Can he <b>play football</b>?</li></ul>	<p><b>-Para hablar de cosas que nos gustan o no.</b></p> <p><b>DO</b> I, you, we, they...? <b>DOES</b> he, she, it ...?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Do</b> you like <b>pizza</b>? <b>Yes, I do.</b> / <b>No, I don't.</b></li><li>• <b>Does</b> she like <b>math</b>? <b>Yes, she does.</b> / <b>No, she doesn't.</b></li><li>• I <b>don't</b> like carrots.</li><li>• He <b>doesn't</b> like English.</li><li>• I like <b>apples and bananas</b>.</li><li>• It likes <b>meat</b>.</li></ul>
