



(the majority)

+ING

PLAYING
EATING
DOING

When the verb ends in -e,
we take off the -e
and add -ing.



+ING

MOVE -- MOVING
COME -- COMING

When the verb ends in a
vowel + l, we double the
consonant.

aeiou + L

CONTROL -- CONTROLLING

VOWEL + 1 CONSONANT
(last syllable is stressed)

consonant

GET -- GETTING
PREFER -- PREFERRING

CHASE -- CHASING

DIG -- DIGGING

LOOK -- LOOKING

TRAVEL -- TRAVELLING
