

Have to / has to + infinitive



Language focus

Use **have / has to + infinitive** to talk about something that somebody else tells us to do.

*He **has to wear** a uniform to school.*

*Miss Smith says we **have to study** for the History test.*

*Do I / you / we / they **have to do it?** Yes, I / you / we / they do. No, I / you / we / they don't.*

*Does he / she **have to do it?** Yes, he / she does. No, he / she doesn't.*
