

Grammar Focus – Future Plans & Predictions

◇ 1. Will ('ll) → Predictions & Spontaneous Decisions

- Use *will* when making predictions based on opinion or belief.
- Also used for decisions made at the moment of speaking.

☑ Examples:

- *I think my team **will win** the next tournament.* (Prediction)
 - *I forgot my water bottle! I **will buy** one at the gym.* (Spontaneous decision)

◇ 2. Going to → Intentions & Predictions Based on Evidence

- Use *going to* for future plans and intentions.
- Also used for predictions based on **present evidence**.

☑ Examples:

- *I **am going to train** harder next season.* (Intention)
 - *Look at those dark clouds! It **is going to rain** soon.* (Prediction based on evidence)

◇ 3. Present Continuous → Fixed Plans & Arrangements

- Use the **present continuous** (am/is/are + verb+ing) for **confirmed, scheduled** events in the near future.

☑ Examples:


- *We **are playing** in a tournament next month.* (Arranged event)
- *She **is meeting** her coach tomorrow morning.* (Fixed plan)
