❖ **Strategy:** Inference from Semantic Context

❖ **Objective:** Develop the ability to infer implicit information based on the meaning of key words and expressions in a text.

### Instructions:

Read each text fragment and select the option that best expresses the correct inference based on the context.

#### Fragment 1
