- Use a writing style that matches the situation.

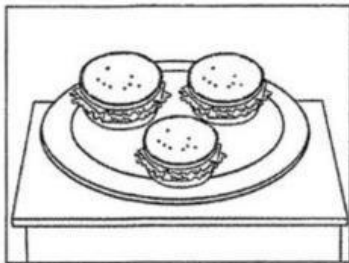
- Use a writing style that is suitable for the reader.

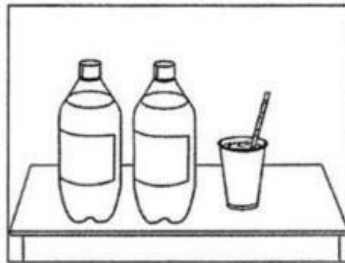

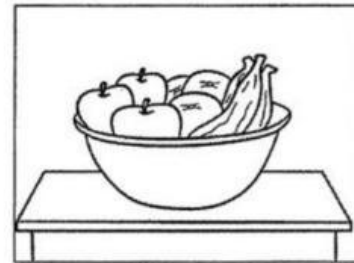
1 What is the girl going to bring for the picnic?
