Instructions:

1. Choose One Topic:
 - A Day That Changed Everything – Write about a day when something unexpected happened and how it affected you.
 - A Difficult Choice I Had to Make – Tell about a time when you had to make a tough decision and what you learned from it.
 - A Time I Overcame a Challenge – Describe an experience when you faced a problem or fear and how you managed to overcome it.
2. Structure Your Story:
 - Introduction: Set the scene and introduce the situation.
 - Rising Action: Describe what led to the main event or problem.
 - Climax: The most exciting or emotional part of your story.
 - Falling Action & Conclusion: Explain how the situation ended and what you learned.
3. Writing Requirements:
 - Minimum 200 words.
 - Use past tense and proper grammar & punctuation.
 - Include descriptive details and dialogue to make the story engaging.
 - Write neatly and legibly on the provided paper. Do not type or print your story.
 - No excessive erasing or scratching out – plan before you write.
4. Submission Guidelines:
 - Write your story on the official paper provided.
 - Write your name and date at the top of the page.
 - Submit the completed story by [insert deadline].
