

THE BOAT SCHOOLS

In Bangladesh from June to October, it rains a lot. Children can't go to their usual school because the roads are under water. But there is an answer to this problem: boat schools!

From June to October, children don't have to go to school-the school goes to them! The boats pick the students up from their homes and the students have their lessons on the boats.

On every boat, there is a classroom for 30 students and their teacher. On the boats, students can use computers and find out information on the Internet. Students can also find out information from books in the libraries on other boats.

These schools help grown-ups, too. There are lessons for them in the afternoons. Here, they can learn how to be better farmers, for example. This is good for women because in lot of villages women must always stay near their homes. With boat schools, learning is easy because the schools go to them.
