* Con respecto a la estructura, la forma continua y la forma gerundio son exactamente las mismas. Sin embargo, aunque todos los verbos pueden usarse como gerundios, no todos los verbos pueden usarse en tiempo continuo. (Y hay otros verbos que tienen un significado con tiempos simples y un significado diferente con tiempos continuos). Exploraremos esto en detalle en una lección futura, pero como este documento pretende ser un recurso / registro, he marcado estos verbos especiales con un asterisco (*).
