Plosive, Velar, Voiceless

/ˈrɒkɪt/
- **Distinctive features:**
Plosive, Velar, Voiceless

The rocket flew into space.

Plosive, Velar, Voiceless

Plosive, Velar, Voiced

- **Distinctive features:**

Plosive, Velar, Voiced

- **Sentence:**

She carries a red bag to school.

- **Distinctive features:**
Fricative, Labiodental, Voiceless
- **Sentence:**

- **Phonetic transcription:**
/ˈkɒfi/
- **Distinctive features:**
Fricative, Labiodental, Voiceless
- **Sentence:**
I love drinking coffee in the morning.

9.LEAF



- **Phonetic transcription:**
/li:f/
- **Distinctive features:**
Fricative, Labiodental, Voiceless
- **Sentence:**
A leaf fell from the tree.

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/v/ as in voice

- Distinctive features:

Fricative, Labiodental, Voiced

- Sentence:

The van is blue is parked outside.

- Phonetic transcription:

/'sevn/

- Distinctive features:

Fricative, Labiodental, Voiced

- Sentence:

I have seven books on my shelf.

Fricative, Dental, Voiceless

- **Phonetic transcription:**

/ˈɔːθər/

- **Distinctive features:**

Fricative, Interdental, Voiceless

- **Sentence:**

He is an author of children's books.

15. BATH

- **Phonetic transcription:**

/bæθ/

- **Distinctive features:**

Fricative, Dental, Voiceless

- **Sentence:**

I need a bath after a long day.

16. THIS

- **Phonetic transcription:**

/ðɪs/

- **Distinctive features:**

Fricative, Dental, Voiced

- **Sentence:**

This is my favorite book.

17. MOTHER

- **Phonetic transcription:**

/ˈmʌðər/

- **Distinctive features:**

Fricative, Dental, Voiced

- **Sentence:**

My mother is always kind to everyone.

- **Distinctive features:**

Fricative, Dental, Voiced

/sʌn/
- **Distinctive features:**
Fricative, Alveolar, Voiceless
- **Sentence:**
The sun is shining brightly today.

- **Phonetic transcription:**
/ˈpensɪl/
- **Distinctive features:**
Fricative, Alveolar, Voiceless
- **Sentence:**
I forgot my pencil at home.



Final position

/glæs/
- **Distinctive features:**
Fricative, Alveolar, Voiceless

She drank water from a glass.
