

**Plosive, Velar, Voiceless**

**Plosive, Velar, Voiceless**

- **Distinctive features:**

Fricative, Interdental, Voiceless

- **Sentence:**

He is an author of children's books.

Fricative, Dental, Voiceless

I need a bath after a long day.
