Roanoke Island was charted 6 ___ 1584 by explorers during the initial expedition. A year later, Sir Walter Raleigh dispatched a second expedition to find a colony there. The island became inhabited 7 ___ Native Americans, who initially greeted the newcomers, although conflicts later erupted and forced them 8 ___ vacate the settlement. In 1587, a third expedition reached Roanoke, 9 ___ a mix of men, women, and children. When the governor returned in 1590, he found the colony in ruins, with a solitary clue carved 10 ___ a tree—“Croatoan.”
