Hey, Lucky and Rocky, \_\_\_\_\_ meal is ready!



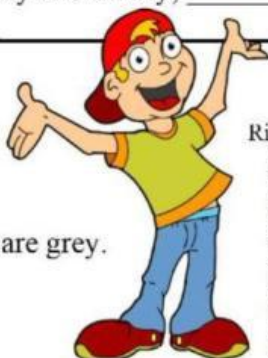
## Exercise 2
