Penguins are special birds that live in cold places, like Antarctica. They have black and white feathers and a thick layer of fat to keep them warm. Unlike most birds, penguins cannot fly. Instead, they use their wings to swim in the water. Penguins are excellent swimmers and can dive deep to catch fish.

Penguins live in large groups called colonies. They help each other stay warm. A mother penguin lays one or two eggs, and both parents take care of the baby penguin. Baby penguins have soft gray feathers when they are young.

Some penguins, like the Emperor Penguin, are very big. Others, like the Little Blue Penguin, are small. Penguins eat fish, squid, and other small sea animals.
