"The cat jumped onto the table."


2. BAKER

"The baker made fresh bread every morning."




3. BACK

9. LEAF

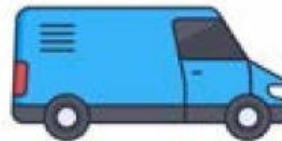

"The leaf fell gently from the tree."


10. VAN

"They planned a dinner for the evening."




12. LOVE

"I told her I love her deeply."




13. THUMB

15. TOOTH

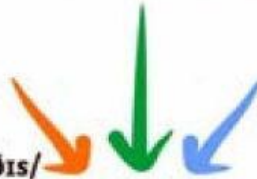


- Phonetic Transcription: /tu:θ/

"I miss my old friends."


22. ZEBRA

"The zebra ran across the field."




23. CRAZY
