2. BAKER



- Phonetic Transcription: /beɪkər/
- Distinctive Features: Plosive, velar, voiceless

Sentence:

"The baker made fresh bread every morning."

3. BACK



- Phonetic Transcription: /bæk/
- Distinctive Features: Plosive, velar, voiceless

Sentence:

"She turned around and looked at the back of the room."

4. GO



- Phonetic Transcription: /gou/
- Distinctive Features: Plosive, velar, voiced

Sentence:

"I told him to go to the store."

5. DOG

- Distinctive Features: Plosive, velar, voiced

"The dog barked loudly at the stranger."

6. FLAG



- Phonetic Transcription: /flæg/
- Distinctive Features: Plosive, velar, voiced

"The flag waved in the wind."

7. FISH



- Phonetic Transcription: /fɪʃ/
- Distinctive Features: Fricative, labiodental, voiceless

"The fish swam in the pond."

8. COFFEE



- Phonetic Transcription: /kɔfi/
- Distinctive Features: Fricative, labiodental, voiceless

"She drank a cup of coffee every morning."

9. LEAF




- Phonetic Transcription: /li:f/

15. TOOTH




- Phonetic Transcription: /tu:θ/

17. FATHER




- Phonetic Transcription: /faðər/
