Fricative, Labiodental

Fricative, Labiodental

Sniff /snɪf/

Fricative, Labiodental

**Sentence:** He took a deep **sniff** of the fresh air.

Van /væn/

Fricative, Labiodental

**Sentence:** The **van** is parked outside.

Seven /'sɛ.vən/

Fricative, Labiodental

**Sentence:** She has **seven** cats..

Love /lʌv/

Fricative, Labiodental

**Sentence:** I **love** my family.

Cat /kæt/

Plosive, Velar

**Sentence:** The **cat** is sleeping on the couch.

Bicycle /'baɪ.sɪ.kəl/

Plosive, Velar

She rides her **bicycle** every morning.

Back /bæk/

Plosive, Velar

He turned his **back** to the audience.

Goat /gəʊt/

Plosive, Velar

**Sentence:** The **goat** is eating grass.

Eagle /'eɪ.ɡəl/

Plosive, Velar

**Sentence:** The **eagle** soared in the sky.

Dog /dɒg/

Plosive, Velar

**Sentence:** My **dog** loves to run in the park.

Think /θɪŋk/

Fricative, Dental

**Sentence:** I think it will rain tomorrow.

Author /'ɔːθə/

Fricative, Dental

**Sentence:** The **author** is signing books today.

Teeth /tiːθ/

Fricative, Dental

**Sentence:** He brushed his **teeth** before bed.

This /ðɪs/

Fricative, Dental

**Sentence:** This is my favorite book.

Brother /'brʌðə/

Fricative, Dental

**Sentence:** My **brother** is taller than me.

Breathe /briːð/

Fricative, Dental

**Sentence:** Just **breathe** and relax.

**Sun** /sʌn/

Fricative, Alveolar

**Sentence:** The **sun** is shining brightly.

**Lesson** /'lɛ.sən/

Fricative, Alveolar

**Bus** /bʌs/
