'Don't worry! It's me!' Jim's dad called. 'Wow! What a <sup>(5)</sup> ..... place! But come on! It's time to go home!'

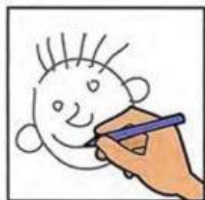
