Phonetic transcription /glæs/

Distinctive features /g/ should be vibrate, voiceless, soft palate

Sentences sample

I like to drink water in the glass with flowers

5 Jungle



Phonetic transcription /jun" + "guh/

Distinctive features /g/ should be vibrate, voiceless, soft palate

Sentences sample

I have never visited the jungle

6 Ghost



Phonetic transcription /gəʊst/

Distinctive features /g/ should be vibrate, voiceless, soft palate

Sentences sample

We can see the ghost from you

7 Driver



Phonetic transcription/draɪ.vər/

Distinctive features /V/ should be vibrate, do not stop flow of air.

Sentences sample: I am driving right now

8 Give



Phonetic transcription/gɪv/

Distinctive features /V/ should be vibrate, do not stop flow of air, stop plosives

Sentences sample

I going to give you a supermarket gift card

9 Vest



Phonetic transcription/vésd/

Distinctive features /V/ should be vibrate, do not stop flow of air.

Sentences sample

She wears the red vest

10 Food



Phonetic transcription/fu:d/

Distinctive features /F/ dental, no vibrate, lower lip

Sentences sample

I love the sea food

11 Coffee



Phonetic transcription/'kafi/

Distinctive features /f/ dental, no vibrate,
lower lip

Sentences sample

They used to drink coffee every afternoon

12 Free



Phonetic transcription/fri:.dəm/

Distinctive features /f/ dental, no vibrate,
lower lip

Sentences sample

Those products were free in the supermarket
