**SOUND /K/ - VOICELESS VELAR PLOSIVE**

**1. CAT**

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:  
*Cat [kæt]*

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:

- Manner of articulation: Plosive
- Place of articulation: Velar
- Voicing: Voiceless

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

*The cat jumped onto the windowsill.*

**2. PICTURE**

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:  
*Picture ['pɪktʃər]*

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:

- Manner of articulation: Plosive
- Place of articulation: Velar
- Voicing: Voiceless

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

*She hung the picture on the living room wall.*

## 3. BLACK

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:  
Block [blæk]

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:

- Manner of articulation: Plosive
- Place of articulation: Velar
- Voicing: Voiceless

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

She wore a black dress to the formal event.

## SOUND /G/ - VOICED VELAR PLOSIVE

## 4. GO

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:  
Go [gəʊ]

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:

- Manner of articulation: Plosive
- Place of articulation: Velar
- Voicing: Voiced

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

We should go to the store before it closes.

**5. BIGGER**

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:  
Bigger ['bɪgər]

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:  
• Manner of articulation: Plosive  
• Place of articulation: Velar  
• Voicing: Voiced

SENTENCE SAMPLE:  
This box is bigger than the one we had before.

**6. DOG**

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:  
Dog [dɒg]

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:  
• Manner of articulation: Plosive  
• Place of articulation: Velar  
• Voicing: Voiced

SENTENCE SAMPLE:  
The dog wagged its tail happily.

SOUND /f/ - VOICELESS  
LABIODENTAL FRICATIVE



## 7. FISH

### PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

Fish [fɪʃ]

### DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:

- Manner of articulation: Fricative
- Place of articulation: Labiodental
- Voicing: Voiceless

### SENTENCE SAMPLE:

They caught a big fish at the lake.



## 8. COFFEE

### PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

Coffee ['kɔfi]

### DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:

- Manner of articulation: Fricative
- Place of articulation: Labiodental
- Voicing: Voiceless

### SENTENCE SAMPLE:

She drinks coffee every morning.



## 9. LEAF

### PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

Leaf [lɪf]

### DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:

- Manner of articulation: Fricative
- Place of articulation: Labiodental
- Voicing: Voiceless

### SENTENCE SAMPLE:

A single leaf fell from the tree.



**SOUND /V/ - VOICED  
LABIODENTAL FRICATIVE**

## 10. VOICE

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:  
Voice [vɔɪs]

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:

- Manner of articulation: Fricative
- Place of articulation: Labiodental
- Voicing: Voiced

SENTENCE SAMPLE:  
Her voice was clear and confident.

## 11. SEVEN

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:  
Seven ['sɛvən]

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:

- Manner of articulation: Fricative
- Place of articulation: Labiodental
- Voicing: Voiced

SENTENCE SAMPLE:  
There are seven days in a week.



## 12. LOVE

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:  
Love [lʌv]

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:

- Manner of articulation: Fricative
- Place of articulation: Labiodental
- Voicing: Voiced

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

Parents show love to their children.



## SOUND /θ/ - VOICELESS DENTAL FRICATIVE



## 13. THINK

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:  
Think [θɪŋk]

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:

- Manner of articulation: Fricative
- Place of articulation: Dental
- Voicing: Voiceless

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

I need to think carefully about this decision.

**14. BIRTHDAY**

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:  
*Birthday* [bɜːθdeɪ]

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:  
• Manner of articulation: Fricative  
• Place of articulation: Dental  
• Voicing: Voiceless

SENTENCE SAMPLE:  
We celebrated his birthday with a cake.

**15. BATH**

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:  
*Bath* [bæθ]

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:  
• Manner of articulation: Fricative  
• Place of articulation: Dental  
• Voicing: Voiceless

SENTENCE SAMPLE:  
She takes a relaxing bath after work.

SOUND /ð/ - VOICED  
DENTAL FRICATIVE



## 16. THIS

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

This [ðɪs]

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:

- Manner of articulation: Fricative
- Place of articulation: Dental
- Voicing: Voiced

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

This book belongs to my sister.



## 17. MOTHER

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

Mother [ˈmʌðər]

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:

- Manner of articulation: Fricative
- Place of articulation: Dental
- Voicing: Voiced

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

My mother taught me how to cook.



## 18. BREATHE

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

Breathe [brið]

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:

- Manner of articulation: Fricative
- Place of articulation: Dental
- Voicing: Voiced

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

Remember to breathe deeply during meditation.



**SOUND /S/ - VOICELESS ALVEOLAR FRICATIVE**

**19. SUN**

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:  
Sun [sʌn]

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:  
• Manner of articulation: Fricative  
• Place of articulation: Alveolar  
• Voicing: Voiceless

SENTENCE SAMPLE:  
The sun shines brightly in the summer.

**20. LESSON**

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:  
Lesson ['lesən]

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:  
• Manner of articulation: Fricative  
• Place of articulation: Alveolar  
• Voicing: Voiceless

SENTENCE SAMPLE:  
We learned an important lesson today.

**21. BUS**

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:  
Bus [bʌs]

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:

- Manner of articulation: Fricative
- Place of articulation: Alveolar
- Voicing: Voiceless

SENTENCE SAMPLE:  
They waited for the bus at the station.

**22. ZOO**

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:  
Zoo [zu]

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:

- Manner of articulation: Fricative
- Place of articulation: Alveolar
- Voicing: Voiced

SENTENCE SAMPLE:  
We visited the zoo last weekend.



## 23. BUSY

### PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

Busy [bɪzɪ]

### DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:

- Manner of articulation: Fricative
- Place of articulation: Alveolar
- Voicing: Voiced

### SENTENCE SAMPLE:

She is very busy at work these days.



## 24. BEES

### PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

Bees [bɪz]

### DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:

- Manner of articulation: Fricative
- Place of articulation: Alveolar
- Voicing: Voiced

### SENTENCE SAMPLE:

The bees collect nectar from flowers.
