Sentence: She loves to bake cookies on Sundays.



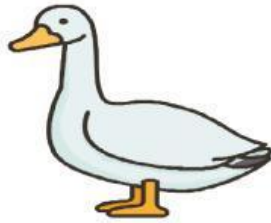
Sound: /k/ Final:

Sentence: The clock stopped working at midnight.



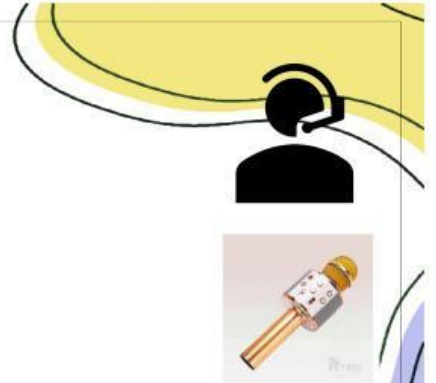
Sound: /g/ Inicial:

Sentence: She lost one glove in the snow.



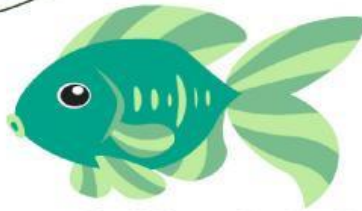

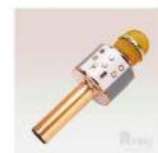
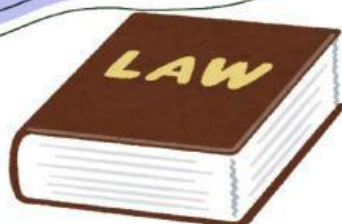
Sound: /θ/ Initial:

Sentence: The zebra has black and white stripes.



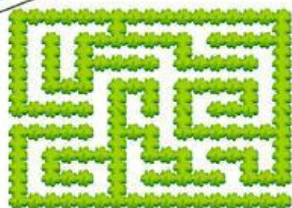
