A **possessive pronoun** refers to a specific owner:  
*mine, yours, my, hers, his, its, your, etc.*

A **relative pronoun** connects a phrase to a noun/ pronoun:  
*who, which, that, whom, etc.*

An **indefinite pronoun** doesn't refer to anything specific:  
*all, any, each, some, several, etc.*
