Sentence: The cat is sleeping on the chair.






2. BAKER

Sentence: The goat climbed the mountain.




2. BIGGER

2. BUTTER




Phonetic transcription: /bʌtə/

Sound /v/


1. VIOLIN

*Distinctive features of /v/: Fricative,
labiodental, voiced.*

*Sentence: He plays the violin in
the orchestra.*



2. RIVER

Phonetic transcription: /rɪvə/

Distinctive features of /v/: Fricative, labiodental, voiced.

Sentence: The river flows to the sea.





Sentence: I hurt my right thumb.




