1. CAR



Phonetic transcription: (kar)

Distinctive features: It is a plosive or stop sound, velar, voiceless.

Sentence: My car is blue.



2. TICKET



Phonetic transcription: (tɪkɪt)

Distinctive features: It is a plosive or stop sound, velar, voiceless.

Sentence: I lost my ticket.



3. BOOK



Phonetic transcription: (bʊk)

Distinctive features: It is a plosive or stop sound, velar, voiceless.

Sentence: Do you like this book?



4. GUITAR



Phonetic transcription: (gi'tar)

Distinctive features: It is a plosive or stop sound, velar, voiced.

Sentence: I play the guitar.



5. ANGRY



Phonetic transcription: (æŋgri)

Distinctive features: It is a plosive or stop sound, velar, voiced.

Sentence: Are you angry?



6. FROG



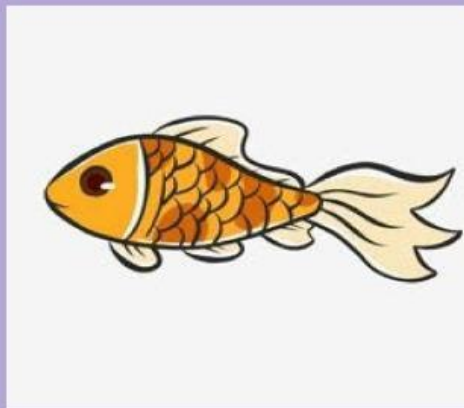
Phonetic transcription: (frɒg)

Distinctive features: It is a plosive or stop sound, velar, voice.

Sentence: The frog is green.



7. FISH



Phonetic transcription: (fɪʃ)

Distinctive features: Fricative, labiodental, voiceless

Sentence: I don't like fish.



8. COFFEE



Phonetic transcription: ('kɒfi)

Distinctive features: Fricative, labiodental, voiceless

Sentence: I drink coffee every day.



9. CHEF



Phonetic transcription: (ʃɛf)

Distinctive features: Fricative, labiodental, voiceless.

Sentence: My sister is a chef.



10. VERY



Phonetic transcription: (vɛri)

Distinctive features: Fricative, labiodental, voiced.

Sentence: This movie is very interesting.



11. DRIVER



Phonetic transcription: ('draɪvə)

Distinctive features: Fricative, labiodental, voiced.

Sentence: My brother is a bad driver.



12. HAVE



Phonetic transcription: (hæv)

Distinctive features: Fricative, labiodental, voiced.

Sentence: I have two cats.



13. THINK



Phonetic transcription: (θɪŋk)

Distinctive features: Fricative, dental, voiceless.

Sentence: What do you think?



14. BATHROOM



Phonetic transcription: (b'aθu:m)

Distinctive features: Fricative, dental, voiceless.

Sentence: Can I use your bathroom?
