Distinctive features of /t/: Plosive, alveolar, voiceless.

Sentence: The table is in the dining room.



2. BUTTER



Phonetic transcription: /bʌtə/

Distinctive features of /t/:
Plosive, alveolar, voiceless.

**Sentence: I like butter on my
bread.**





3. LIGHT

Phonetic transcription: /laɪt/

Sound /v/

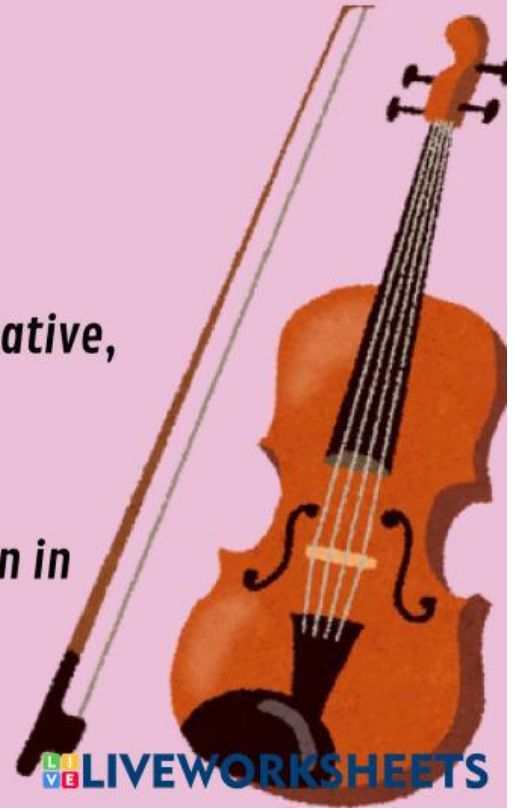
1. VIOLIN
