

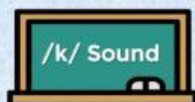

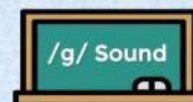

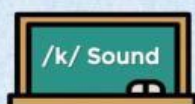
Phonetic Transcription:

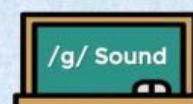
Phonetic Transcription:

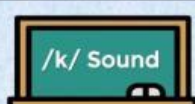

Bake

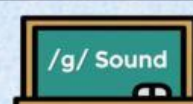
Phonetic Transcription:

Fricative, labiodental, voiced.

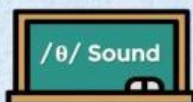

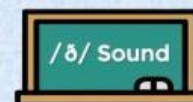

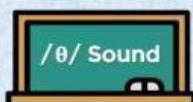

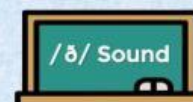

Mother

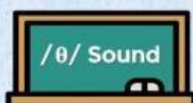

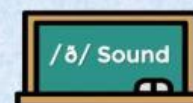

Lather

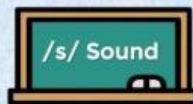

Sad

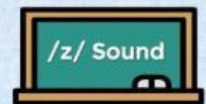

Zone

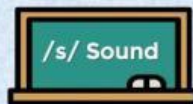
Phonetic Transcription:

Sing

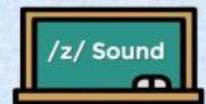

Rise

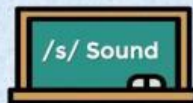
Phonetic Transcription:

Ice

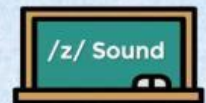
Phonetic Transcription:
