WHAT	Asking for information about something	A: <i>What is this?</i> B: <i>It's a pencil case.</i>
WHEN	Asking about time	A: <i>When</i> does your school start? B: <i>It starts at 8:00 o'clock.</i>
WHERE	asking in or at what place or position	A: <i>Where</i> do you live? B: <i>I live in London.</i>
WHO	asking what or which person or people (subject)	A: <i>Who</i> works in a hospital? B: <i>A nurse</i> works in a hospital.
WHY	asking for reason, asking what...for	A: <i>Why</i> does she want to learn English? B: <i>Because</i> she wants to live in England.
WHICH	asking about choice	A: <i>Which colour</i> do you want? B: <i>I want blue</i> one.
