Him	People	Masculine	Singular
It	Things	Both	Singular
Them	Both	Both	Plural



We use direct pronouns to replace the thing or person receiving the action.


Indirect pronouns	Type	Gender	Number
Her	People	Femenine	Singular
Him	People	Masculine	Singular
Them	Both	Both	Plural



We use indirect pronouns to replace the person who receives something.
