Phonetic transcription:

Phonetic transcription:  
/ mæθ /

Distinctive feature for /θ/:  
Voiceless, dental, fricative

Sentence sample:  
There's a math test  
tomorrow.



## 16. THIS

Phonetic transcription:  
/ ðɪs /

Distinctive feature for /ð/:  
Voiced, dental, fricative

Sentence sample:  
This is my notebook.



## 17. RATHER

Phonetic transcription:

/ˈræ.ðə/

Distinctive feature for /ð/:

Voiced, dental, fricative

Sentence sample:

I would rather be safe  
than sorry.



## 18. BREATHE

Phonetic transcription:  
/ bri:ð /

Distinctive feature for /ð/:  
Voiced, dental, fricative

Sentence sample:  
My cat its black and cute.





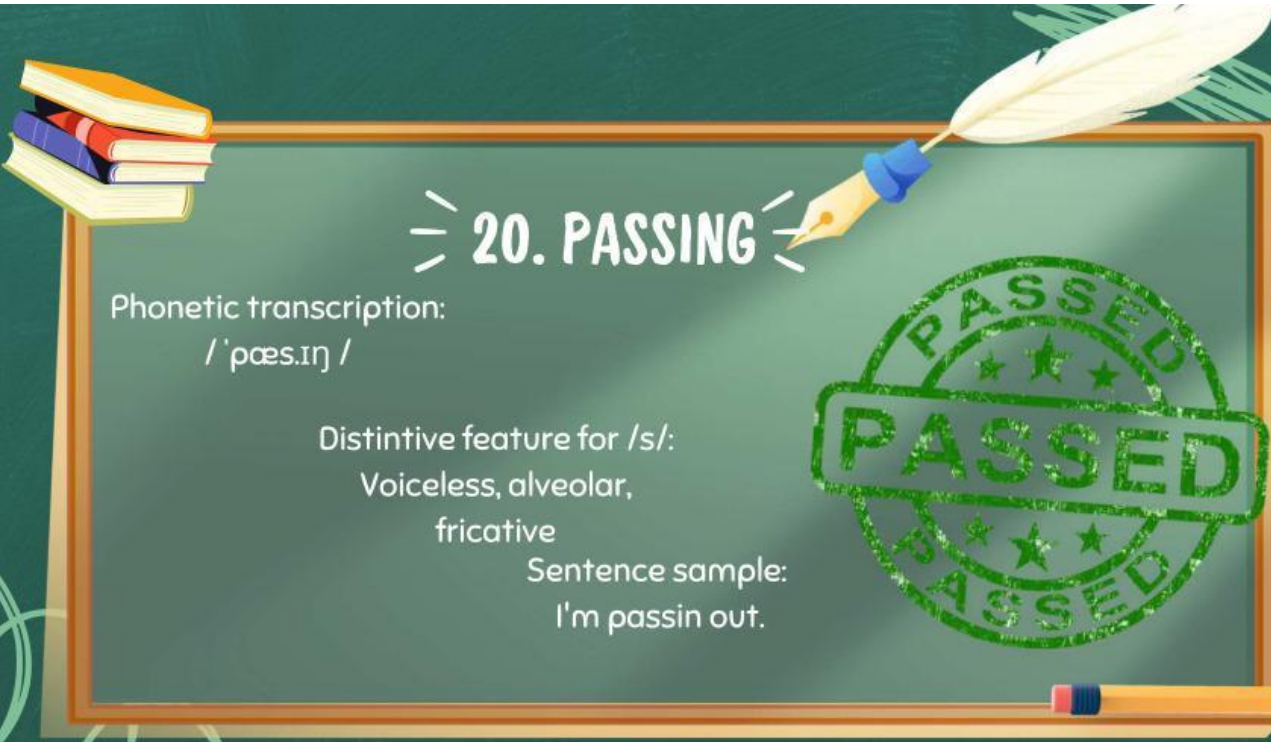
19. SUN

Phonetic transcription:  
/ sʌn /

Distinctive feature for /s/:  
Voiceless, alveolar,  
fricative

Sentence sample:  
The sun can't be seen at  
night.





## 20. PASSING

Phonetic transcription:  
/ˈpæs.ɪŋ/

Distinctive feature for /s/:  
Voiceless, alveolar,  
fricative

Sentence sample:  
I'm passin' out.

## 21. BUS

Phonetic transcription:  
/ bʌs /

Distinctive feature for /s/:  
Voiceless, alveolar,  
fricative

Sentence sample:  
I will take a bus to get  
there quick.



22. zoo

Phonetic transcription:  
/ zʊ: /

Distinctive feature for /z/:  
Voiced, alveolar, fricative

Sentence sample:  
There are many animals  
at the zoo.



## 23. BUSY

Phonetic transcription:  
/ 'bɪ.zi /

Distinctive feature for /z/:  
Voiced, alveolar, fricative

Sentence sample:  
I can't go out right now I'm  
busy.





## 24. BUZZ

Phonetic transcription:  
/z/

Distinctive feature for /z/:  
Voiced, alveolar, fricative

Sentence sample:  
I can hear the bee's buzz  
nearby.
