Speaking Activity: Would You Rather?

Objective: Practice fluency, express your opinions, and justify your choices.

Instructions:

1. Read each question carefully.
2. Choose one option and explain your choice.
3. Give reasons and examples to support your answer.
4. Try to use expressions like:

- *I would rather... because...*

- *In my opinion...*

- *I prefer... because...*

- *On one hand... but on the other hand...*

Questions:

1. Would you rather travel to the past or the future? Why?
 2. Would you rather have the ability to fly or be invisible?
 3. Would you rather live in a big city or a small town?
 4. Would you rather always have to tell the truth or never speak again?
 5. Would you rather spend a year without a phone or a year without your favorite food?
 6. Would you rather be famous but unhappy or unknown but happy?
 7. Would you rather live by the ocean or in the mountains?
 8. Would you rather have a job you love but earn little money or a job you hate but earn a lot?
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Writing Activity: My Perfect Choice

Objective: Develop your writing skills, structure your ideas, and explain your opinion in detail.

Instructions:

1. Choose one of the "Would you rather" questions from the speaking activity.

2. Write a **short essay (150-200 words)** explaining your choice.

3. Follow this structure:

1. Introduction – Present the two options and state your choice.

2. Body – Give at least two reasons with explanations or examples.

3. Conclusion – Summarize your opinion and reinforce your argument.

✓ *Body:*
